SCIENCE

1. Research based –

Mass vaccination against COVID – 19 is considered to be the most effective strategy to bring the COVID – 19 pandemics under control. In unprecedented global scientific effort, 11 vaccines have been authorised for full or emergency use throughout the world.

Make a power point presentation on Covaxin/Covishield vaccine being used in India under the following topics:

- Introduction of vaccine
- Manufacturing companies and production
- How does vaccine work?
- Efficacy of the vaccine
- Side effects (if any)
- Pictures of vaccine drive in India.

Parameters: authenticity of content, presentation, analysis, creativity.

2. Creativity based –

- (a) Make a working model, showing phases of moon. (Roll no. 1 to 10)
- (b) Make a model of Human nerve cell by using biodegradable materials. (11 to 20)
- (c) Make a model, showing interlocking of the two surfaces by using clay. (21 to last)

Parameters: creativity, oral presentation, neatness, scientific knowledge.

3. Observation based –
