


MATHEMATICS

4. Cartoon Character-

SCIENCE

1. Research based –

(a) Antioxidants are called "scavengers of free radicals". These prevent cell damage caused due to free radicals produced in the body.

Make a power point presentation on antioxidants under the following topics:

- (b) Types of antioxidants
- (c) Sources
- (d) Health benefits.

Parameters: authenticity of content, presentation, creativity, scientific knowledge.

2. Observation based –

Collect samples of vinegar, lemon juice, mustard oil or coconut oil or any other liquid. Take a glass tumbler. Fill it up to half with water. Add a few spoonsful of one liquid to this and stir it well. Let it stand for five minutes. Observe whether the liquid mixes with water. Repeat the same with other liquids, as many different liquids as are available to you. Write your observations in Table. Also take pictures while doing it and make a collage on an A3 sheet.

Parameters: authenticity of content, presentation, creativity, scientific knowledge

3. life skill based –

"Staying Healthy the Cheaper way". Search internet/any other sources and find out easily available local, cheaper alternative food items that can be included in diet to make it whole some and easily affordable.

For example: Expensive dry fruits/nuts can be replaced by groundnuts, chestnut etc.

Collect information regarding the local and cheap alternatives of food and make display cards for any five foods.

Value based – inform your maid, sweepers or other helping hands about these food that help to stay healthy.

4. Seeds are the bearers of life of a plant. A new plant can be grown from the other parts of a plant too, such as stem, leaves and roots.
